

Brose honors suppliers with Supplier Awards 2024



This year's award ceremony took place at Brose location in Bamberg.

This time, a total of four suppliers were recognized for their commitment and excellent performance in the areas of innovation, quality and sustainability.

Alpas won in the category innovation for its AI-driven procurement software, which enables Brose to search for suppliers more quickly and efficiently.
