

German Chancellor Olaf Scholz meets Brose representatives in Shanghai

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As part of his second trip to China since taking office, German Chancellor Olaf Scholz visited the business metropolis of Shanghai on April 15. At a round table, he exchanged views with representatives of German companies in China on economic cooperation between the two countries.
